



## **Board Policy 311: President Appointment**

### Administration

The Iowa Valley Community College District Board of Directors may employ a President for a term of not to exceed three years. However, the Board's initial contract with a President shall not exceed one year if the Board is obligated to pay a former President under an unexpired contract.

The President, who serves as an ex-officio member of the Board (without vote), will be the Executive Officer of the Board and have such powers and duties as may be prescribed by rules adopted by the Board or by law.

The President will have professional training, expertise, practical experience, and talent appropriate to meet the demands of this office.

The IVCCD Board of Directors will at least once annually review the performance of the President in terms of Board expectations.
